District Genealogy

The spread of Rotary Clubs in District 1020

The first Scottish clubs are the Rotary Clubs of **Glasgow** and **Edinburgh**. These two founder clubs were formed by the Irish-born 'entrepreneur' William Stuart Morrow (right) in 1912.

Glasgow Rotary Club (RIBI Club number 5) went on to directly establish **Dumfries** (RIBI 47 in 1922); **Inverness** (RIBI 55, 1922); **Hamilton** (RIBI 201 in 1926); **Kilmarnock** (RIBI 260 in 1927); **Paisley** (RIBI 291, 1928); **Rutherglen** (RIBI 517, 1944); **Queen's Park** (RIBI 672, 1948); **Kelvin** (RIBI 676, 1948); **Rothsay** (RIBI 700, 1950); **Govan** (RIBI 733, 1952); **Greenock** (RIBI 773, 1953); **Dennistoun** (RIBI 804, 1955), **Glasgow North and Bishopbriggs** (RIBI 963, 1962); and **Eastwood** (RIBI 1130, 1971).

The **Dumfries** club is mother club to **Kircudbright** (no.660, 1948); **Thornhill & District** (no.1244, 1975); **Annan** (no.685, 1949); and **Dumfries Devorgilla** (no.1907, 2002). The **Annan** Club is mother to **Lockerbie** (no.1196, 1973) while **Kircudbright** formed clubs in **Castle Douglas** (no.972, 1963); and **Stranraer** (no.761, 1953). **Castle Douglas** organized **Dalbeattie** (no.1264, 1976) and **Stranraer** organized **Newton Stewart** (no.1040 in 1967).

Other 1020 clubs devolve from **Hamilton** who sponsored the **Motherwell and Wishaw** Club (no.336) in 1930. **Lanark** is another of **Hamilton's** 'daughters' being formed in 1950 (club no. 707) and established **Biggar** (no.1298, 1977) who then established **West Linton and District** (no.1596, 1986). The **Motherwell** club were especially busy in forming daughter clubs –



Coatbridge and Airdrie (no.446) in 1936; **Bellshill** (no.959) in 1962; **Carluke** (no.1363) in 1979; and **Larkhall** (no.1183) in 1973. The **Coatbridge** club went on to sponsor clubs in **Cumbernauld** (no.1038) in 1966; **Monklands** (no.1276) in 1976 and **Kirkintilloch** (no.746) in 1952.

The three clubs last mentioned are, therefore, great- great- granddaughter clubs of **Glasgow!**

If we think the **Glasgow** club was busy in spreading the Rotary ideal in Scotland, the **Edinburgh** club surpassed their city rivals by a substantial margin by establishing clubs all over Great Britain beginning in 1917 and last spreading Rotary in 1993.

Edinburgh established no less than 22 clubs starting with **Leeds** (RIBI no.11) in 1917; **Leicester** (no.13, 1916); **Portsmouth and Southsea** (no.14, 1916); **Bristol** (no.15, 1917); **Perth** (no.16, 1917); **Cardiff** (no.17, 1917); **Nottingham** (no.18, 1918); **Derby** (no.20, 1918); **Dunfermline** (no.45, 1921); **Kirkcaldy** (no.48, 1921); **Falkirk** (no.167, 1924); **Hawick** (no.429, 1936); **Peebles** (no.591, 1946); **Leith** (no.734, 1952); **Musselburgh** (no.769, 1953); **Portobello** (no.771, 1953); **Corstorphine** (no.814, 1955); **Galashiels** (no.854, 1957); **Haddington** (no.921, 1960); **Murrayfield Cramond** (no.1161, 1972); **Braids** (no.1162, 1972); and **Edinburgh Breakfast** (no.1791, 1993).

One of **Edinburgh's** daughter clubs – **Falkirk** – organised the district 1020 clubs of **Grangemouth** (no.679, 1949); **Bathgate** (no.748, 1952); **Denny** (no.860, 1957); **Larbert** (no.1137, 1971); **Polmont** (no.1201, 1974) who sponsored the most recent club in district 1020 – **Edinburgh Park**.

These daughter clubs have also been busy extending Rotary. **Grangemouth** organised the **Linlithgow and Bo'ness** club in 1955 (no.803). This club helped form the Rotary Clubs of **South Queensferry** (no.1296) in 1977 and **Linlithgow Grange** (no.1758) in 1991. **Bathgate** is mother club to both **Livingston** (no.1216, 1974) and **Whitburn** (no.1538, 1984). **Whitburn**, in turn, is mother club to the **Shotts and District** Rotary Club (no.1668, 1988). **Denny** is mother club to **Kilsyth** (no.1200, 1974).

Another of **Edinburgh's** daughter clubs – **Hawick** – sponsored the **Langholm** club in 1977 (no.1293) while the **Peebles** Club helped form the **Innerleithen, Walkerburn and Traquair** club (no.1565) in 1985 and **Melrose** (RIBI no. 1973) in 2009.

Musselburgh is mother club to both the **Dalkeith** (no.1050, 1967) and **Penicuik** (no.1101, 1969) clubs. **Penicuik** is the mother club of **Loanhead and Roslin** (no.1500, 1983) While **Dalkeith** is mother to **Esk Valley** (no.1895, 2001).

Corstorphine sponsored the **Currie-Balerno** club (no.1445, 1981).

Galashiels extended Rotary in the borders towns of **Kelso** (no.1151, 1971); **Selkirk** (no.1257, 1976) and **Lauderdale** (no.1632, 1976). The **Kelso** club is mother to **Jedburgh** (no.1239, 1975).

Within East Lothian, **Haddington** sponsored clubs in both **Dunbar** (no.983, 1964) and **North Berwick** (no.1037, 1966). **Dunbar**, in turn, is mother to both **Tranent** (no.1134, 1971) and **Eyemouth & District** (no.1163, 1972). **Dunbar**'s daughter club is **Eyemouth** who in turn is mother to **Duns** (no.1224, 1974). **Tranent** is mother to **Longniddry & District** (no.1395, 1980).
